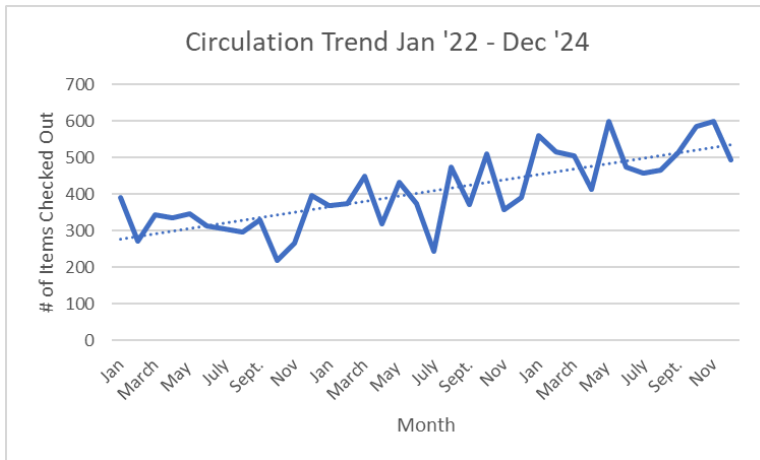
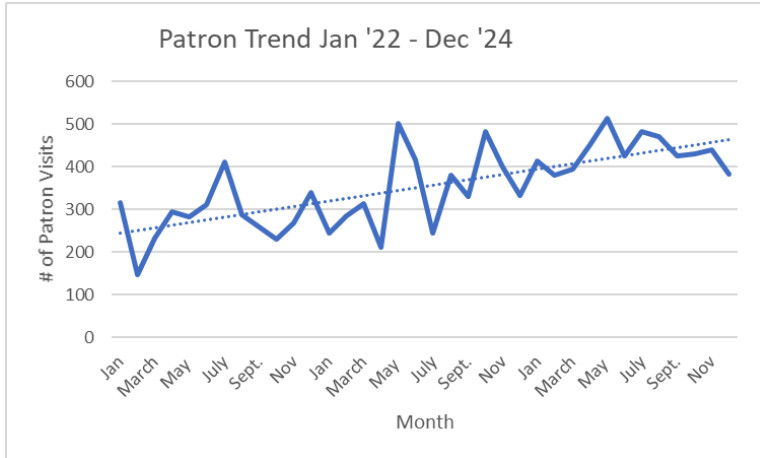

Library Trends

Compared to previous years, in 2024 the library saw an increase in both patrons, and materials being checked out.

Both patronage and circulation have had an upward trend over the past two years.

Construction Project

- Volunteers removed several non-load-bearing walls at the former M&T Bank location.
- Asbestos abatement was performed at the former M&T Bank location.
